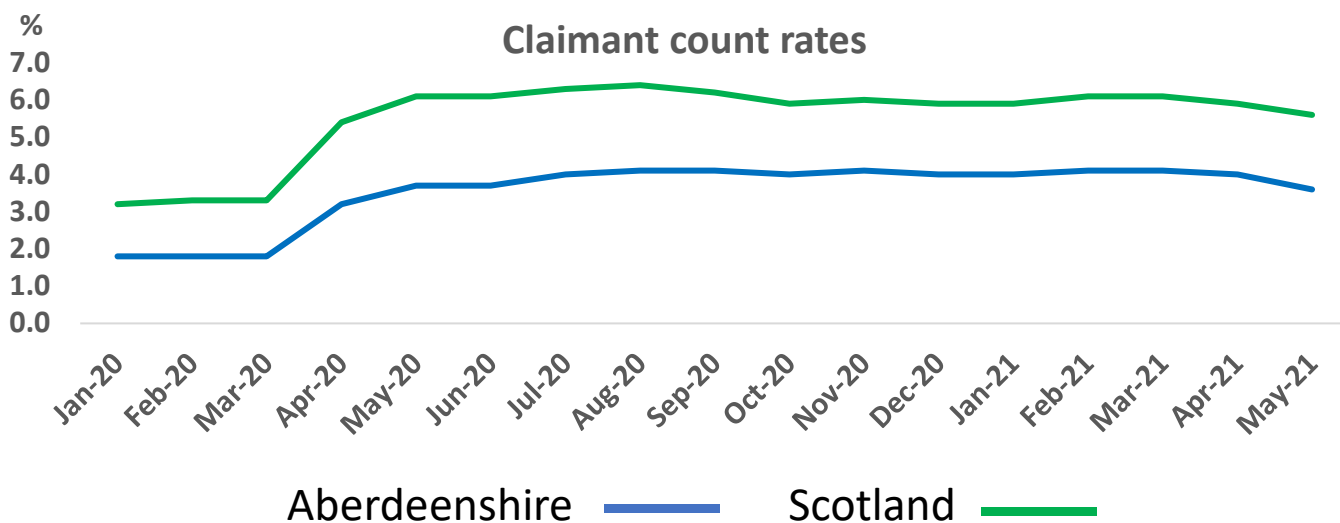




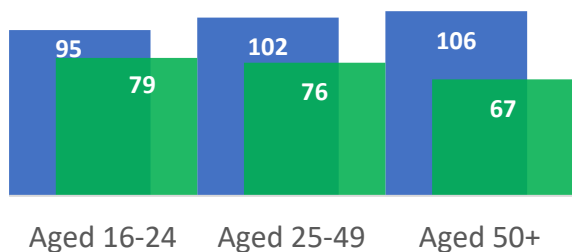

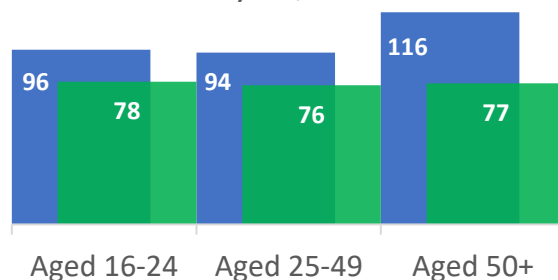
Unemployment – January 2020 to May 2021

Jan 20 - May 21, **Females**

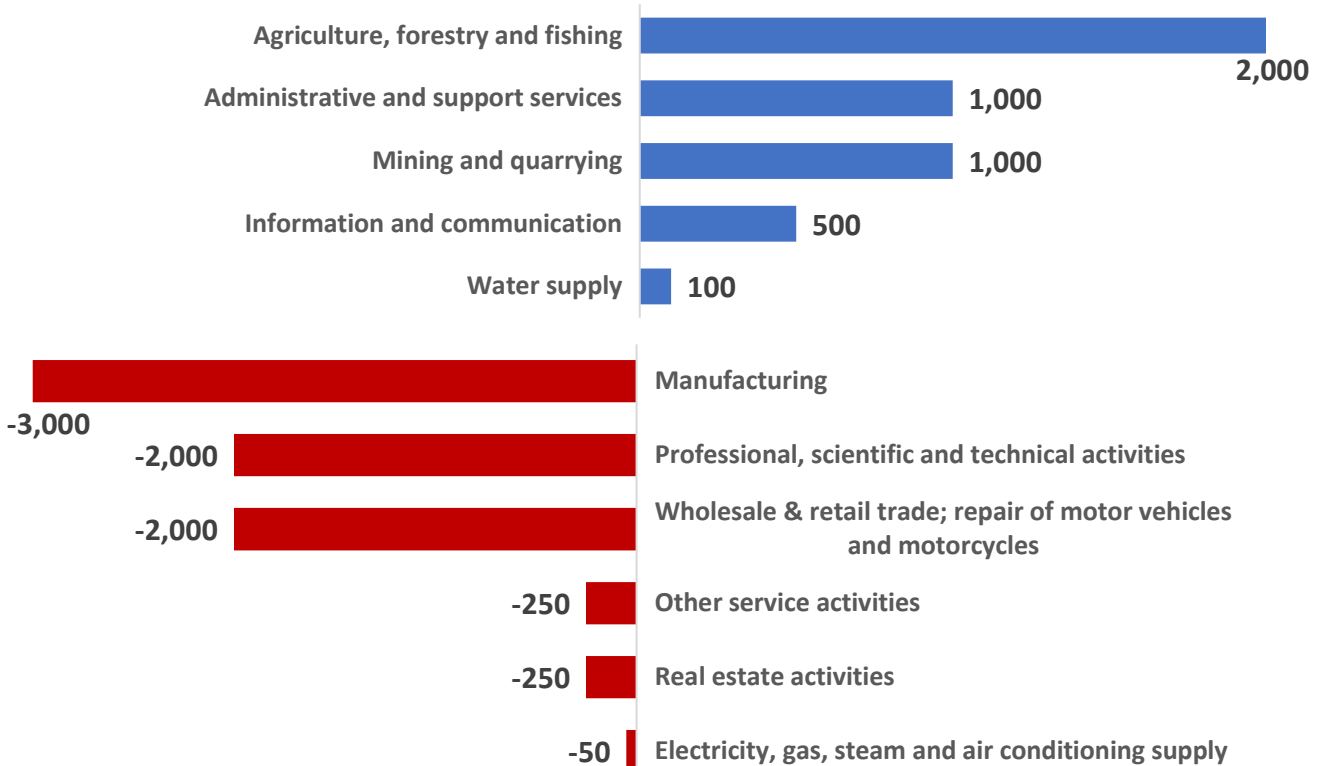


Percentage change in unemployment

Change in numbers employed 2015 – 2019



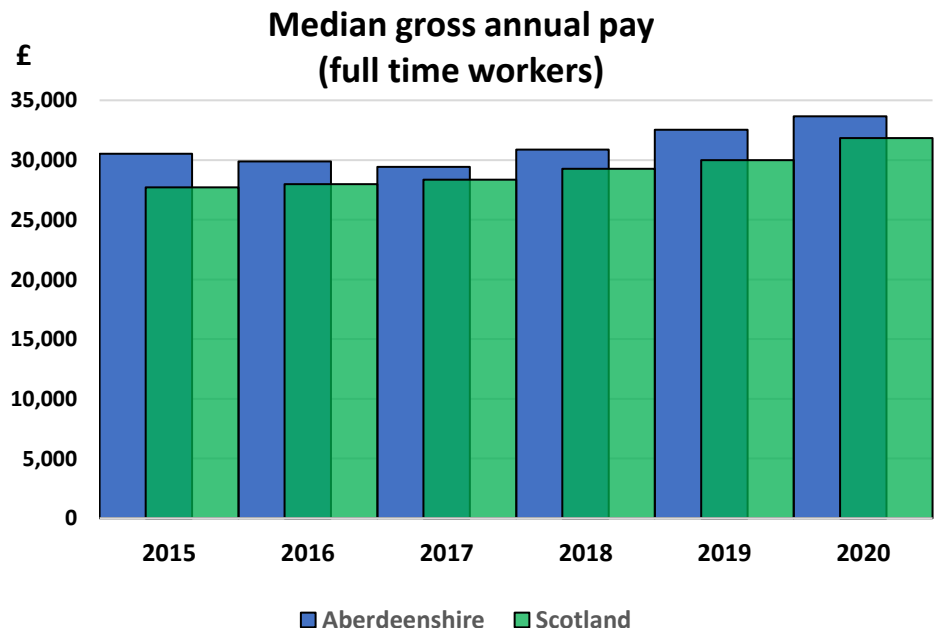

Median gross annual pay increased by 10.3% in Aberdeenshire and by 14.9% in Scotland between 2015 and 2020.

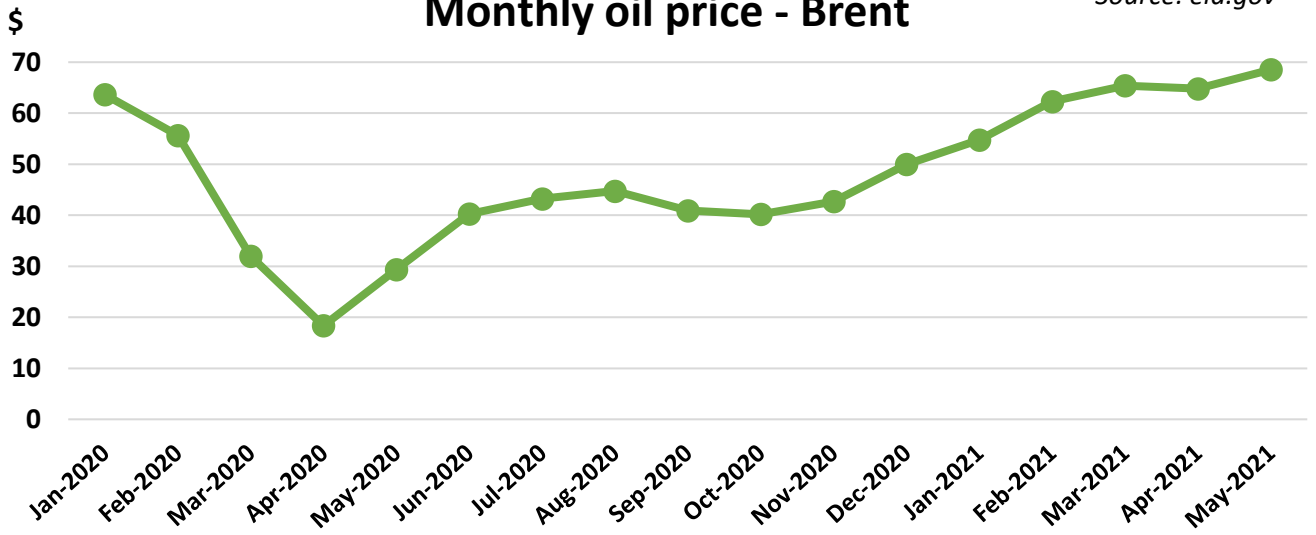

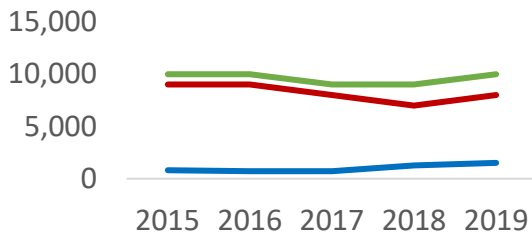
Monthly oil price - Brent

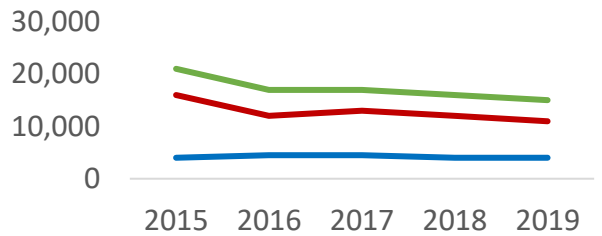


Number of employees

Support activities for petroleum and natural gas extraction

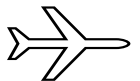
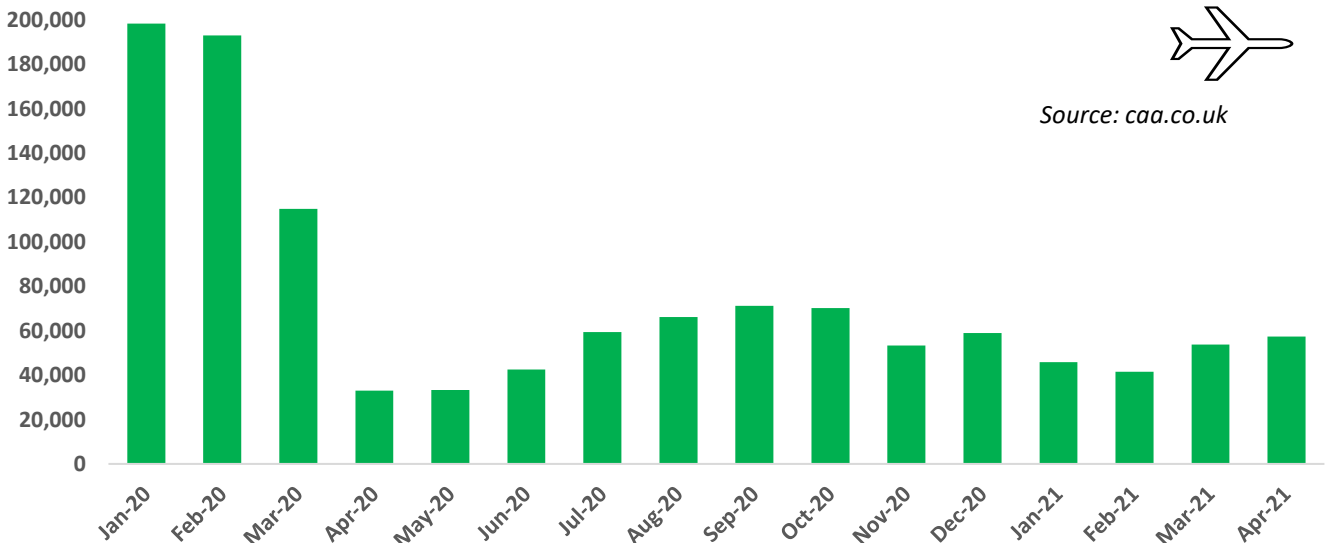

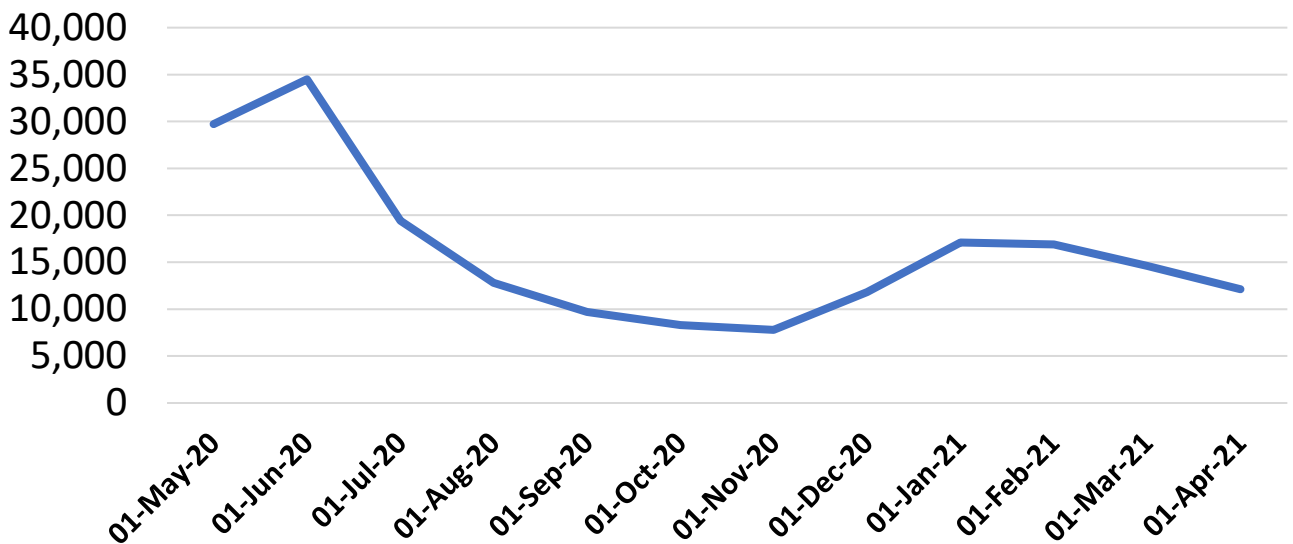
Aberdeen Airport Passenger Numbers

Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme

Jobs furloughed in Aberdeenshire



42,300 jobs have been furloughed in Aberdeenshire since the beginning of the scheme

At 31 March 2021 14,400 jobs were furloughed in Aberdeenshire

Female jobs on furlough = 7,800

Male jobs on furlough = 6,600

Total take-up rate of eligible jobs
12%

At 31 March two sectors accounted for almost 40% of furloughed jobs.

These were the **accommodation & food services** sector and the **wholesale & retail; repair of motor vehicles** sector.
